

## **neoConneX Supports Windows 2008 Server!**

In order to support a system with more incoming and outgoing connections than a workstation operating system allows, **neoConneX** now supports Windows 2008 Server. There are a few conditions on which we will support this server based OS though. The following conditions must be met for us to be able to support **neoConneX** on Windows 2008 Server.

### ***Windows 2008 Server - Terms & Conditions of Support:***

- The server **must be** dedicated to running only **neoConneX**.
- The server **must not be** a virtual server **unless** you have a way of virtualizing the USB ports across a network.
- The server **must not be** a primary domain controller for a domain or be acting as a router or DNS server.

### ***Additional Options:***

- The SQL Server needed for **neoConneX** **can be** located on another member server if desired.
- The web applications (**neoConneX** Reporting and **neoConneX** AVL) **can be** located on another member server if desired.

**Note:** If separating the different components of **neoConneX** onto different servers, they must all be resolvable inside the LAN where **neoConneX** is being hosted.

**Note:** You must ensure (if hosting services to others outside the LAN) that the proper ports are forwarded to the IP of the machine where the web-based applications will reside.
